# RISHIKUL GURUKUL

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATION

- The Gurukul prides it self for its high standards of discipline and code of conduct. All students are expected to conform to its code for personal hygiene, turnout, punctuality, conduct, discipline, obedience, sense of responsibility, attitude towards academics etc.
- In enforcing these norms and discipline, the Gurukul looks forward to full co-operation and support from the parents/guardians to ensure a healthy and all round growth of their wards taking full advantages of opportunities and facilities here; and to enable the Gurukul, its system and programmes to run efficiency. If a students contravenes the normal code of expectations, rules or regulations in this respect, he/she can incur warning and punishment.

### POINT TO REMBER TO STUDENTS

- The students should be regular and punctual. They should reach Gurukul at least 5 mintues before the Hawan bell.
- Children should come in proper Gurukul Uniform and must wear their identity card.
- The students shall be neatly and tidily dressed in the prescribed uniform.
- Students are not supposed to sing movie songs in the Gurukul or class activity.
- Students must bring proper, healthy and nutritious food. Packet products and junk food are not allowed.
- Wearing of jewellery, valuable articles and cosmetics is not permitted.
- Students must pay attention to personal hygiene.

- Use of abusing language, quarrelsome behavior, shouting and whistling is not allowed.
- Students are expected to be courteous, polite, well mannered, honest, truthful, respectful and obedient toward the teachers, all elder and visitors.
- Money will not permitted in Gurukul. If it is found form any students it will be deposit in the office.
- Students shall not indulge in disfiguring or damaging Gurukul properties. If any class found this securtity deposit of whole class will be deducted.
- If any students finds any articles belonging to someone else, he/she shall deposit it in the office instantly.
- Students are strictly not allowed to come in casual dresses on PTM or any other day. Except only on occasions when they are asked to come. They must come in Gurukul uniform.
- Students must wear only Black Shoes.
